A few general points to this year's tournament

32 teams will play this year's tournament. There will be four groups, each group consisting eight teams.

Five group phase games will be played on Saturday and the final two on Sunday. The four best teams of each group will qualify for the eighth-final.

Important points:

- A game lasts for twelve (2X6) minutes.
- A win is rewarded with three, a draw with one and a loss with zero points.
- A team consists of five field players and one goalie.
- Metal cleated football shoes and combat boots are not prohibited on the field.
- You are allowed to substitute as much as you want.
- The goalkeeper is allowed to pick up return passes. Field players are not allowed to touch up the ball.
- There will be no offside rule.

! We will no longer be providing footballs before the games. Please bring your own footballs if you would like to use them to warm up.

! You will play on agricultural land and not on a football field. So you have to expect unevenness and other conditions as usual.

Fairplay

Fairplay always comes first! We desire a tournament where the enjoyment and love of the game is always at first place! To underline this point, there will be an additional ranking. At the end of the group phase each team will be able to select the fairest team in their group. The team with the most points will be awarded with three additional points.

In our usual tradition, we will, as every year without referees. There will however be someone observing the games, which will note the result after each game. After every game a player from each team should confirm the result.

We would like to emphasize that the Antira-Cup is against any form of discrimination. Let us demonstrate this together on and off the field!

- Infostore Cigno Nero

Pazzo Sinistra is against any form of discrimination in and around the stadium; their objective is to advocate a colourful and diverse fan-culture.

- Kiez und Rufa

- FAU - the free workers union

- IWW

The Industrial Workers of the World (IWW) are a grassroots Union initially originating from the United States of America.

Together with other labour movements around the world, the IWW aims to improve the labour conditions of all workers. The objective is to fight for just wages, which allow for a life in dignity. This fight needs to take place on an international scale, not only in Germany, Austria and Switzerland.

- Animal Rights Group Zurich

We contest the exploitation of animals in slaughterhouses, experimental laboratories and through the fur industry. We take part in campaigns against companies that profit from such activity. To advocate our ideas and goals we also organize demonstrations and actions. Also we stand in solidarity with comrades who have been subjected to state repression. The distribution of the communiqués from the Animal Liberation is also part of our daily work. Finally we also organise theoretical lectures and workshops to the topic of animal rights.

- Building perspectives - Solidarity with Rojava

In the midst of the civil war in Syria, a segment of the northern population has stood up to build a society on the foundation of democracy, feminism and ecology. Due to the war against the IS a vast amount of the region has been demolished. The successful resistance against the IS has however lead to international recognition. Still Northern Syria needs to however defy a large amount of enemies: Besides the IS and other jihadist militias, the Turkish air strikes and the international embargos cause for difficult circumstances. "Building perspectives - solidarity with Rojava" is a group with supports different projects, which are currently engaged in rebuilding the region. Furthermore the group attempts to guarantee information to the current situation.
